- Group F – for juniors up to 10 years old, born in 2012 and earlier
- Group G – for juniors up to 8 years old, born in 2014 and earlier

7. Prizes:

- A cup for the group winner, which shall be handed out during the closing ceremony on 19.08.2023 at 19.00, and medals in the boys and girls categories, which shall be handed out after the last round.
- Prizes in kind, All players shall receive a souvenir before the last round, whereas the prizes for places I-III shall be handed out after the last round.

8. Conditions of participation:

- In order to participate in the tournament, you must send your application by August 10, 2023 to the following email address: office@chessustron.pl with group, name, category, ranking, club and date of birth or via chessarbiter.com server.
- The entry fee has to be paid until 10.08.2023 by bank transfer to the Silesian Chess Federation account no **97 1600 1462 1019 5563 7000 0001** Payment title: Wpisowe Ustron + group + name.
- The player who has submitted an application and payment on time shall arrive straight at the first round. The starting list and the confirmations of payment shall be regularly updated on the Festival's website chessustron.pl
- It is possible to pay the entry fee in cash. Then the fee is increased by PLN50 and payable in the Festival Office between 12-14.08.2023.
- No refund will be granted after payment of the entry fee.
- Entries on the day are not possible. Late applicants may play from the second round.
- Starting lists of the E, F, G groups shall be published on 15.08.2023 at 8.00 p.m.
- Organised groups of more than ten chess players (chess clubs, schools, chess camps, summer camps) shall be granted a 10% discount on the entry fee if it is paid by bank transfer until 30.06.2023.
- It is a condition of entry that players agree to their information being published on the tournament website, the chessmanager website and their rating information being published.

9. Rules:

- In the tournament the current FIDE and PZSzach regulations shall apply.
- An appeal against an assistant arbiter's decision must be made to the Chief Arbiter of the tournament immediately after issuing the decision on payment of a PLN300 deposit at the Festival Office. The PLN300 deposit will be returned if the Chief Arbiter finds in favour of the party requesting the review. A continuation of the game means that the verdict of the assistant arbiter has been accepted. It is a condition of entry that players accept that, in the event of a dispute, the Chief Arbiter's decision is final.
- The failure of a player to appear within 15 minutes after the start of play will be treated as a default.
- Cell phones or other electronic communication devices may be brought to the playing hall on the condition that they are switched off and kept in a separate bag, handbag or backpack. Electronic devices that are switched off may be left at a designated place for the duration of the game on one's own responsibility.
- A player with a cell phone or other electronic communication device switched on in the playing hall shall lose the game.

10. Final remarks:

- Za The players or their guardians are responsible for their condition to play.
- The players shall insure themselves.
- The players, fans and parents are asked to keep peace and quiet in and around the playing hall.
- The players are obliged to observe special safety rules, according to legal regulations, including the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector and comply with current restrictions introduced with regard to preventing and reducing the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus.
- The organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or accident during the tournament. Adult supervision will only be provided in the chess playing areas. Parents or guardians are responsible for their children during the tournament. The organisers and helpers are not able to take responsibility for any child's actions, or the actions of anyone that may affect your child.
- Each player automatically consents to the collection, processing and transfer of their personal data for the purpose the tournament, in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the Protection of Personal Data.
- Each player automatically consents to granting the right to the publication of the photos of the player for the purpose of the promotion of the Festival.
